We took the same stylish bed and gave it three come-hither looks by dressing it up in different linens (for instant redecoration, replace the rug, lamp and bed tables too). Produced by Linda O'Keeffe and Tara McLellan. Written by Sarah Lynch.

GOOD-NIGHT KISS We started our sweet-dreams fantasy of cozy fireside cuddling with an appealingly simple contemporary bed—Baronet's chocolate-stained maple Vendome from Crate & Barrel (queen, \$1,299). Then we fitted it out with eyelash-soft handkerchief-linen sheets from Decadence (fitted, \$598) and Jhane Barnes's handwoven 46-by-72-inch rayon chenille throw in coffee (\$130). Teddy sits on Jennifer McGee's cashmere/silk cable-knit 18-inch-square pillow (\$160), his back against a 100 percent handkerchief-linen sham from Decadence (\$219); behind that is Matteo's 32-inch box pillow

in pumpkin mohair (\$394). For extra warmth, snuggle up in 525's acrylic chenille 60-inch-square in fern (\$72). We planted our bed on Angela Adams's plush handtufted Hankshaw rug in chocolate New Zealand wool (\$83/sq. ft.; the 5-by-7-foot rug shown is \$2,905). For night tables, we used a pair of Modénature's 15-inch-square poufs in dark brown cowhide from Intérieurs (\$1,390 each) and topped them with sculptural candles from Umbra: the 12-inch-long Pebble (foreground) and 13-inch-high Meta (\$13 and \$20). The brown ponyskin mules with rabbit fur trim are by Yohji Yamamoto (\$925). >
